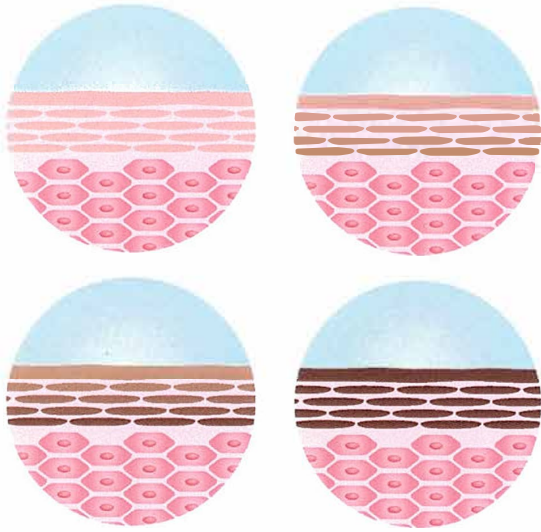


WHAT IS HYPERPIGMENTATION?
